The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C praying for quashing of FIR No.168 dated 14.10.2020 registered under sections 354-D, 294, 506, 509 IPC and Sections 67 and 67(A) of Information Technology Act at Police Station, Civil Lines, Bathinda, District Bathinda along with all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 23.1.2021 (Annexure P-2).

The report of the concerned Illaqa Magistrate has been received, wherein it has been mentioned that there is one more victim in this case namely Jaswinder Kaur. Petitioners have entered into compromise only with one victim, whereas the another victim i.e. Jaswinder Kaur has not entered into any compromise with the petitioners.

Learned counsel appearing for victim Jaswinder Kaur has affirmed the aforementioned position.

In view of the above position, present petition is dismissed. However, parties are at liberty to avail the alternate remedies as available to them in accordance with law.
