SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

1. The present petitioner is the mother of deceased one, Sagar Kataria. The above Sagar Kataria, is alleged in FIR No.257 of 25.11.2020, registered at Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar Rural, to be murdered by accused named in the FIR (supra).

2. The petitioner avers in the petition, that since there is every likelihood of endangerment to her life accruing from the threats being meted by the accused in FIR (supra), thereupon, co-respondent No.3 be directed to provide adequate security to her for warding off any life endangering threats, as may emanate from the accused in FIR (supra). Though, there is no tangible, and, concrete evidence in respect of the above made prayer, but yet to ensure that the old aged mother of the deceased feels secure, thereupon co-respondent No.3, is directed to ensure regular patrolling of the abode of the present petitioner, and, to also ensure that as, and, when the security is asked for by her, to grant her the asked for security.

3. Though, a further prayer is made in the petition regarding the readiness, and, the lethargy of investigations being conducted into FIR (supra).

However, learned State counsel submits, that some of the accused in the FIR (supra), are arrested, and, with respect to un-arrested accused proceedings for theirs becoming declared proclaimed offenders have been drawn, by the learned trial Magistrate concerned. Therefore, it appears that there is no tardiness in the investigation, by the investigating officer concerned, into FIR (supra).

4. In consequence, the above made averment against the police officials concerned, are unmeritworthy, and, are rejected.

5. In view of the above observation, the petition is closed, and, disposed of accordingly.
