VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

This is a first petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for quashing of FIR No.130 dated 22.08.2017 registered under Sections 306, 34 IPC at Police Station Sadar Sri Muktsar Sahib, District Sri Muktsar Sahib and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

The parties were directed to get the statements recorded in respect of compromise and the trial Court was directed to submit report thereafter.

A perusal of the report would show that Varinder Kumar has since deceased and his LRs, including his mother Raj Rani, have not been made party.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after impleading all the necessary parties and entering into compromise with them.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty. In case any such petition is filed, then the same would be considered independently, on its merits, in accordance with law.
