The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.16 dated 07.02.2022 registered under Sections 307, 341, 34 IPC and 25, 27 of the Arms Act at Police Station Division No.1, Jalandhar.

The operative part of the order dated 16.03.2022, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the allegations in the FIR are that the unidentified persons stopped the vehicle of the complainant Amanpreet Singh and fired a shot, however, no one was hit. It is further submitted that the son of the petitioner namely Aman has already been arrested and on his disclosure statement, the petitioner has been nominated in the case.

Notice of motion.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 16.03.2022, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from the

Investigating Officer, has not disputed the factual position and submits that though the petitioner has joined the investigation, however, during investigation, Sections 120-B and 109 of the IPC have also been added as the petitioner was found to be in conspiracy with other accused.

The Registry is directed to make the necessary corrections in the head note as well as prayer clause of the petition, thereby adding Sections 120-B and 109 of the IPC.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 16.03.2022, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

It is clarified that this order shall be read in addition to Sections 120-B and 109 of the IPC, which have been added subsequently.
