[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 22.07.2019, in CWP No.19892 of 2019.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1), reveals that CWP No.19892 of 2019 was disposed of by directing respondent No.3 herein to consider and decide the claim of the petitioner against the backdrop of representation dated 01.06.2019 and take a decision thereupon within 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case of finding any amount due, to release the same to the petitioner forthwith.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of speaking order (Annexure R-1) dated 16.09.2020, deciding representation dated 01.06.2019 and releasing payment to the petitioner as per entitlement determined therein, the petitioner is not interested in

pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
