1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 24.07.2019, in CWP-20116-2019.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1, reveals that CWP-20116-2019, was disposed of vide order dated 24.07.2019, by directing respondent No.2 to examine the claim of the petitioner against the backdrop of legal notice dated 01.06.2019, and take a final decision in respect thereto as expeditiously as possible and in any case within eight week, from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case any amount was found payable / outstanding, necessary funds be released to the petitioner, without any further delay.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order Annexure P/1 dated 24.07.2019, in CWP-20116-2019, the respondents have released payment to the petitioner as claimed in legal notice dated 01.06.2019, therefore, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against respondent No.2, under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
