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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.152 dated 28.09.2021 under Sections 307, 452, 323, 325 IPC, Police Station Dakha, District Ludhiana Rural.

The FIR was lodged on the complaint of one Avtar Singh. He stated that he is having a house on Kulara Road, Village Dhatt. Ram Dulara, his servant was residing there. The complainant had fixed barbed wire to prevent the stray cattle in the fields. On 27.09.2021 at about 8.30 P.M., the petitioner Surjeet Singh was going to the house of his brother Lakhbir Singh. He was under the influence of liquor. On seeing the barbed wire, he entered into the house of the complainant and started

abusing Ram Dulara. The petitioner was carrying an axe and he caused a blow on the head of Ram Dulara. On raising hue and cry, the petitioner fled away from the scene along with the weapon.

As per the CT scan report, Ram Dulara suffered 'depressed comminuted fracture of right parietal and frontal bone with hemorrhagic contusion, SAH, SDH & midline shift'.

Ld. counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is behind bars since 30.09.2021. To settle down the adverse feeling between the parties, they have entered into compromise (Annexure P-3). Affidavit of injured Ram Dulara in this regard is also annexed as Annexure P-5.

In view of the above facts and circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed. The petitioner **(Surjeet Singh)** is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
