Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that though, the petitioner has challenged the transfer order dated 04.03.2021 (Annexure P/10) but, the petitioner is not pressing the same, at this stage as the petitioner already joined her station of posting.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view various family problems being faced by the petitioner, the petitioner intends to approach the respondents with a prayer that she may be posted near Gurugram, where the post is vacant and the petitioner can be accommodated.

Learned State counsel submits that in case any representation is filed by the petitioner, the same will be considered by the respondents in accordance with law and an appropriate order on the same will be passed within a period of two months from the date of receipt of the said

representation and in case the prayer of the petitioner for posting to a station near Gurugram is found to be feasible/in accordance with law, the same will be granted to her.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view the above, the present petition may kindly be disposed off having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.
