The present writ petition has been filed with a prayer that respondent No.5 has installed a khokha in front of the property belonging to the petitioner in an illegal manner by encroaching the public street.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the said encroachment has been brought to the notice of the Authority concerned but even as of now, no action has been taken by the Municipal Corporation concerned. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 04.01.2022 (Annexure P-6), raising the grievance as raised in the present petition and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is given to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Navdeep Chhabra, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, keeping in view the advance service of copy of the petition, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4.

Learned State Counsel submits that the State has no objection in deciding the representation dated 04.01.2022 (Annexure P-6) in a time bound manner.

Without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to pass the appropriate speaking order on the representation dated 04.01.2022 (Annexure P-6), filed by the petitioner, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of the copy of this order.

It is made clear that before passing the order on the representation, all the persons including respondent No.5, who are likely to be affected by the outcome of the said order be given an opportunity of hearing to present their case.
