The petitioner complains non-compliance of the order dated 03.12.2021 passed in CWP-17617-2021. The operative part of the order reads as under:-

“At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if its representation dated 31.07.2021 (Annexure P-13) is decided by respondent No.2 within a time bound manner.

Learned State counsel has no objection to the aforesaid prayer.

In view of aforesaid, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to decide the representation dated 31.07.2021 in accordance with law, preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.”

Ms. Upasana Dhawan, AAG, Haryana, has entered appearance on behalf of respondent pursuant to supply of advance copy of the contempt petition and submits that certain information has been sought from the Additional Chief Secretary, Health and on receipt of the same, the matter will be considered and decided.

It is evident that the directions were issued by the High Court on 03.12.2021 and a period of more than 4 months has elapsed. Respondent was required to decide the matter within a period of one month. Ms. Upasana Dhawan, AAG, Haryana, on instructions from Sh.Vinod Bhardwaj, DA, office of Chief Secretary, assures the Court that the order dated 03.12.2021 will be complied with positively within a period of two weeks, from today.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no further order is required to be passed. However, it is made clear that if the order passed on 03.12.2021 is not complied with within a period of two weeks, from today, as stated by the learned State counsel, the Chief Secretary, Haryana, shall be liable to pay costs of Rs.25,000/-which shall be deposited in the account of Poor Patients Welfare Fund, PGI, Chandigarh.

Disposed of.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
