Learned counsel for the petitioner, at this stage, addresses a limited prayer for directing respondent no.3 to decide the Consolidation proceedings under Section 42 of the East Punjab Holding (Consolidation and Prevention of Fragmentation) Act, 1948 (for short ' the Consolidation Act') in a time bound manner pursuant to remand of the case vide order dated 31.05.2016, Annexure P-2 passed by the Commissioner, Gurgaon Division, Exercising Power Under Section 42 of the Consolidation Act. It is submitted that no headway has been made in the matter despite the matter being remanded in May 2016.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State does not raise any serious objection to the restricted prayer addressed.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances as above, but without expression of any opinion on the merits of the case, this writ petition

is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.3 to decide the matter after giving proper opportunity of hearing to all the concerned/affected parties in accordance with law in a time bound manner and preferably within six months from receipt of certified copy of this order.
