The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.195 dated 13.04.2018 registered under Sections 323, 406 and 498-A IPC at Police Station, Shahabad, District Kurukshetra on the basis of a compromise dated 12.03.2022 (Annexure P-2) entered into between the parties.

On 21.03.2022 this Court had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/Trial Court for recording of their respective statements with regard to the compromise, who in turn was directed to submit a report along with the recorded statements with regard to the veracity of the compromise between the parties as also to apprise this Court whether all the accused are party to the compromise; whether any of them have ever been declared proclaimed offender(s) and if is there any other criminal case pending against them.

As directed, report dated 25.03.2022 from the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Shahabad has been received as per which the parties had recorded their statements before the Trial Court in terms of the compromise

arrived at between them; the same is genuine, voluntary, out of free will of the parties and without any influence and coercion; only the petitioner is arrayed as accused and that he has not been declared a proclaimed offender in the present FIR.

Learned State counsel has no objection if the present petition is allowed.

In view of the above, continuation of the proceedings in pursuance of the afore-referred FIR which arises from a matrimonial dispute as also the matter having been compromised, would be an abuse of the process of law and in terms of the law laid down by a Full Bench of this Court in *Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others*, 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, this Court deems it just and proper to allow the petition and resultantly quash FIR No.195 dated 13.04.2018 registered under Sections 323, 406 and 498-A IPC at Police Station, Shahabad, District Kurukshetra and all proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioner.
