This is a petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.70 dated 03.06.2021, registered under Sections 323, 506, 147 and 188 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 3 of the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897 & 52(B) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, at Police Station 1, Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

Learned State counsel has pointed out that in addition to respondent No.2, there are other victims i.e. Gurvinder Singh Kalsi, Satish Kumar and Mandeep Kaur, who have not been made party in the present case.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, in view of the above, seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after making all the victims/complainant party in the present case and after entering into compromise with all the said persons.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
