Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of FIR No.126 dated 20.06.2019, registered for offences under Sections 363, 366-A and 376 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 4 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, at Police Station City Rajpura, District Patiala, Annexure P-1, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 13.02.2020, Annexure P-2, arrived at between the parties.

Upon instructions received from ASI, Gurpreet, State counsel submits that the petitioner has been convicted vide judgment passed in July, 2021 and CRA-S-777-2021 filed by the petitioner challenging conviction is pending before this Court. He submits that the petitioner has not disclosed these facts in the instant petition.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has approached this Court with tainted hands, this Court is not inclined to accept the prayer made in the petition.

Petition is dismissed.
