AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

1. This petition was filed for issuance of directions to the official respondents for protection of life and liberty of the petitioners from the private respondents No. 4 to 11 arrayed in the petition.

2. As per the pleadings, the petitioner was in a live-in-relationship with respondent No.12 and there was a threat perception.

3. On 28th March, 2022 following order was passed:-

“xxxxxx xxxxxx xxxxxx

Main petition

Notice of motion to the respondents.

Mr. Dhruv Dayal, Senior DAG, Punjab appearing on advance notice accepts the same on behalf of official respondents and seeks time to have instructions.

To ensure the safety, in the meantime the police officials shall take the petitioner to Safe House and be kept there till the next date of hearing.

Adjourned to 19.4.2022. ”

4. Learned State counsel submits that the statements of the petitioner has been recorded by Mr. Parminder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Dhuri, District Sangrur. It is stated

therein that there is no threat perception and they don't apprehend any danger.

5. In view of the above, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present petition.

6. The petition is disposed of as infructuous
