1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 21.12.2021, in CWP-26196-2021, in case titled as ASI Jaibir Singh and another vs. State of Haryana and others.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 dated 21.12.2021, reveals that CWP-26196-2021 was permitted to be withdrawn with liberty to the petitioners to file a comprehensive representation before the respondent within one week from the date of order and in case any representation was filed by the petitioners, the respondent was directed to consider and decide the same in accordance with law, after taking into account all aspects of the matter, as expeditiously as possible.

3. Notice has not yet been issued in the instant case but on 28.03.2022, learned DAG, Haryana, had taken time to obtain instructions and assist in the matter. Today, learned DAG, Haryana, has produced copy of order dated 16.04.2022, passed by the respondent, rejecting the

thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners, who on perusal of the same, states that in the circumstances, the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same, with liberty to challenge order dated 16.04.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioners as prayed for.
