The instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus seeking issuance of directions to the respondents No. 1 to 6 to take appropriate legal action against respondent No.7 and 8, who are allegedly attempting to forcibly recover the vehicle bearing registration No. PB-02-BS-9750 with the help of recovery agents.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that he is already paying the requisite installments and that he undertakes to pay the remaining installments in time and that in the event no default has been committed by the petitioner, the respondents be called upon to not act in any manner which is in breach of law.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.7 does not controvert the same and submits that in the event of the petitioner paying the due/overdue installments as per the schedule, he undertakes to not take any steps that are in breach of any law.

In view of the aforesaid statements made by respective parties, the present petition is disposed of as no further directions are required from this Court.

Needless to mention that the parties shall remain bound by their respective statements made in Court today.
