Due to COVID-19 situation, the Court is convened through video conference.

This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking regular bail in case of FIR No.84 dated 25.3.2021, under Section 379-B read with Section 34 IPC (offence under Section 201, 120-B IPC added lateron), registered at Police Station Bilaspur, District Yamunagar, Haryana.

One of the ground for seeking bail is the custody period.

Learned State counsel submits that the prosecution evidence is at fag end, out of total eleven prosecution witnesses, seven witnesses have been examined and next date fixed is 31.3.2022. She on instruction submits that earnest effort would be made to examine all the remaining prosecution witnesses within two months from the date fixed.

In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition at this stage.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

No doubt, in case a request is made before the trial Court for accommodating dates for an early conclusion of prosecution evidence, the same would be considered in accordance with law.
