The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C praying for quashing of FIR No.200 dated 24.12.2011 under sections 506, 509 I.P.C (section 354 IPC deleted), registered at Police Station, Phillaur, District Jalandhar and all the subsequent proceedings on the basis of compromise dated 1.2.2019 (Annexure P-2).

Vide order dated 5.3.2019 parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate concerned for recording of their statements and the report of the Illaqa Magistrate was also called for.

The report from Illaqa Magistrate concerned has been received, which shows that respondent no.2 Hardev Singh Johal did not appear before the court as he has been declared as Proclaimed Offender since 17.4.2017

Learned counsel for the petitioner as well as counsel for respondents no.2 and 3 make a joint request that they may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to challenge the order dated 17.4.2017 by virtue of which respondent no.2 has been declared Proclaimed

Offender. Liberty is also prayed for to approach this Court again at the

appropriate stage.

Prayer is allowed.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberties, as prayed for.
