Petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 for investigation of the case bearing FIR No. 101 dated 05.07.2019, under Sections 304-B/34 IPC (Section 302 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station City Batala in a fair and reasonable manner and submit the final report in a time bound manner.

On instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Singh, learned State counsel submits that during the course of investigation, respondent Nos.5 and 6 have been declared innocent. Furthermore, respondent No.4 i.e. the husband of the deceased has been declared Proclaimed Offender on 31.08.2022 by the Court of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Batala. The report under Section 173 Cr.P.C will be submitted shortly as respondent No.4 has been recently declared Proclaimed offender.

In these set of circumstances, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petition may be disposed of as no further action has been called for.
