1. The petitioners have approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.352 dated 06.09.2019 registered at Police Station Ladwa, District Kurukshetra, under Sections 323/341/379-B & 506 IPC and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 19.03.2021, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.
3. Report of learned District & Sessions Judge, Kurukshetra, has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of accused/petitioner, namely, Balwinder @ Pata @ Yogi and also of

complainant Naresh Kumar have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves.

4. The complainant Naresh Kumar in his statement has stated that he has no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.
5. The learned District & Sessions Judge, Kurukshetra has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise without there being any kind of influence or coercion.
6. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.352 dated 06.09.2019 registered at Police Station Ladwa, District Kurukshetra, under Sections 323/341/379-B & 506 IPC and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioner.
