This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of the FIR no.11 dated 22.10.2020 registered under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC and Section 13 of the Punjab Travel Professionals (Regulation) Act, 2014 at Police Station NRI, District SBS Nagar and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise.

A perusal of the memo of parties would show that only Amarjit has been impleaded as respondent no.2 and the other victims, i.e. Paramjit Kaur, Vinod Kumari Sharma and Kuldeep Singh who are victims, as per the report of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, SBS Nagar, have not been made party.

In view the above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after making all the victims / complainant as party in the petition.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
