Prayer in the instant application is for placing on record the relevant documents of essential qualification of the petitioner as well as representation dated 24.03.2022 as Annexures P-29 and P-30 respectively.

Application is allowed and Annexures P-29 and P-30 are taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that though, in the present petition, the petitioner has challenged the action of terminating his

services on the ground that the petitioner does not fulfill the minimum eligibility of good academic record for the post of Assistant Professor, for which he was working as guest lecturer, but after the filing of the present petition, the petitioner has filed a detailed representation dated 24.03.2022 (Annexure P-30) and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case the respondents are directed to pass a speaking order deciding the said representation in a time bound manner.

Learned State counsel submits that State has no objection in deciding the representation of the petitioner dated 24.03.2022 (Annexure P-30) by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of two months from the receipt of this order and in case, after passing the speaking order, the petitioner is found entitled for any relief, the same will be extended to him within a period of one month thereafter.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned State counsel, no further grievance survives in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.

As the main petition stands disposed of, no orders are required to be passed in the miscellaneous application No.CM-17292-CWP-2021 as well.
