1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 07.01.2022, in CWP-185-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 07.01.2022, reveals that CWP-185-2022, was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider legal notice dated 28.08.2021, as representation moved by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order preferably within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case of finding the petitioner entitled to and there being no impediment for the grant of relief, to release the benefits to the petitioner without any delay as per law.

3. Learned AAG, Punjab, refers to order Annexure R/1 dated 11.05.2022, accepting the claim and releasing full payment as per entitlement along with interest @ 6% per annum to the petitioner. The

same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the

petitioner, who admits having received payment as per order Annexure R/1 dated 11.05.2022 but prays for liberty to challenge the award of interest @ 6% per annum instead of 12% per annum as claimed, by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
