AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition was filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 414 dated 24.10.2016 registered under Sections 406/420/467/468/471 IPC, 1860 at P.S. Taraori, District Karnal and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that matter was not compromised and it was One Time Settlement (OTS) which was relied upon by the petitioner. He on instruction submits that terms and conditions of OTS were also not adhered to.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has no instructions from his clients.

The quashing is sought on the basis of compromise while the compromise itself is a debatable document as it is OTS, conditions of which is not being adhered to.

In view of the above, petition is dismissed.
