Present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.63 dated 17.06.2018 under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506 and 34 IPC registered at Police Station Subhanpur, District Kapurthala and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the complainant had since died, however, the copy of the death certificate having been provided by him to the Police authorities, the same had not been submitted before the Court concerned, wherein the cancellation report stands presented, on account of which the matter pending for finalization of the said report was being unnecessarily delayed.

Learned State counsel on 03.11.2022 had sought time to submit that said certificate before the Court concerned.

Learned State counsel on instruction for ASI Bakshish Singh submits that on 23.11.2022, the said death certificate has since been produced before the

Court concerned and the case is pending for consideration on 09.12.2022.

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition may be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present case.
