This is the first petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR no.103 dated 01.05.2020 registered under Sections 302, 34, 120-B IPC at Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, seeks to withdraw the present petition, at this stage. It is prayed that since the petitioner has been in custody since 02.05.2020 and there are 23 witnesses and even the charges have not been framed as yet, the trial be expedited and the alleged eye witnesses, i.e. complainant, Balwinder Singh and Dharminder Singh be examined as expeditiously as possible.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, at this stage. The trial Court is requested to expedite the trial and in case charges are framed

witnesses. The State is also directed to produce the said witnesses as expeditiously as possible and even the counsel for the accused is also directed to assist the trial Court in examining the said witnesses for expeditious disposal of the case.
