[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order (Annexure P-1) dated 29.10.2021 in CWP No.21886 of 2021.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP No.21886 of 2021 was disposed of by directing the Deputy Commissioner, Fazilka, to consider and decide representation dated 22.10.2021 within 06 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Learned counsel states that pursuant to notice issued in the instant case, the respondent has taken decision dated 24.03.2022 on the representation and granted relief to the petitioners as prayed for in the representation and that in the circumstances, the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of

learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
