Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.12 dated 24.02.2022, under Sections 354, 354-A,294 IPC, registered at Police Station Maloud, Khanna, District Ludhiana.

By virtue of the order dated 17.03.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Harminder Singh has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 17.03.2022, is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
