Vide order dated 17.03.2022, this Court had granted interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 17.03.2022, the petitioner had joined the investigation.

3. This fact has not been disputed by the learned State counsel. However, learned State counsel has opposed the bail. He further submits that in case this Court is inclined to give the bail to the petitioner then it should be subject to the strict and stringent conditions.

4. Given the nature of allegations, no pre-trial incarceration is required. Without commenting on the case's merits and the circumstances peculiar to this case, the petitioners makes a case for release on bail.

5. Given above, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 17.03.2022, is hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall strictly abide by the conditions specifically contained in Paragraphs 21 and 22. It is further clarified that if the petitioner repeats the offence, this will have a bearing on bail in future cases.
