The petitioner is seeking directions to the respondents to release the amount of contributory provident fund contributions which were made by him along with interest accrued thereon.

The petitioner was appointed as a temporary Special Police Officer on 28.02.1994 and was absorbed on regular basis to the post of Constable on 21.11.2006. Since the year 2004, a new Contributory Pension Scheme has been introduced, therefore, the petitioner, who had made contributions under the CPF, now seeks refund of the same in terms of the orders passed in CWP-15003-2020 titled as *Parveen Kumar and others Versus State of Punjab and others*, decided on 21.09.2020 and CWP-475-2021 titled as *Sohan Lal and others Versus State of Punjab and others*, decided on 11.01.2021.

At this stage, Mr. C.L. Pawar, Senior DAG, Punjab, who is present through the medium of video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of respondents.

The present writ petition is disposed of by giving a direction to the respondents to take a final decision on the legal notice dated 23.11.2021 (Annexure P-5) and pass a speaking order thereon, within a period of two months, from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
