Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No. 91 dated 26.06.2020, registered under Sections 323, 324, 506, 427, 34 and 379-B IPC, at Police Station Haryana, District Hoshiarpur.

Vide order dated 17.03.2022, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 17.03.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Satish Kumar, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.
