[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 29.10.2021 in CWP No.21238 of 2021.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 dated 29.10.2021 reveals that CWP No.21238 of 2021 was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide the claim made in the legal notice dated 22.09.2021 in accordance with law after taking into account all aspects of the matter within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case the claim was accepted, to release benefits to the petitioner as per his entitlement within four weeks thereafter.

[3] Pursuant to notice issued to the respondent to show cause as to why proceedings under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 be not initiated against him, learned State counsel has produced copy of communication from the Director General of Police, Punjab, GPF Branch to the Advocate

General, Punjab Chandigarh bearing Memo No.1344 GPF/A-3 05.04.2022 intimating that amount of NPS Rs.3,32,689/- has been deposited in bank Account No.13391000004376 of the petitioner bearing IFSC code HDFC 0001339 on 04.04.2022. The aforementioned communication is taken on record and copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
