The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of appropriate order/direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to transfer the investigation in case FIR No.9 dated 25.01.2020 registered under Sections 420, 406 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Division 6, District Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar to some senior police officer outside District Jalandhar and to initiate action against respondent No. 4.

Today, the case has been called twice, but no one has appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

Learned State counsel has pointed out that in the present case

after the investigation, the cancellation report has been submitted in the Court on 15.02.2022 and notice has also been issued to the complainant/present petitioner and the same is now fixed on 17.05.2022. It is submitted that in view of the said facts, nothing survives in the present petition.

Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, moreso, the fact that the prayer in the present petition is for direction to the official respondents to transfer the investigation and after the filing of the present petition, the investigation has already been completed and the cancellation report has also been submitted and notice has been issued to the complainant/present petitioner and the said case is now fixed on 17.05.2022, the present petition is, thus, dismissed as having been rendered infructuous. However, the liberty is granted to the petitioner to file a protest petition or any other application/petition, in accordance with law.
