Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution primarily for quashing the impugned order dated 03.03.2022 (P-6), whereby petitioner was directed to continue to hold the additional charge of Govt. Sr. Sec. School Lapon, District Moga for three days in a week after her transfer to Govt. Sr. Sec. School, Surapur, District SBS Nagar.

In response to the notice of motion, competent authority has passed the order dated 13.06.2022, whereby prime grievance of the petitioner stands satisfied.

Faced with the above situation, learned Counsel on instructions from petitioner does not press the present petition any further. However, he submits that for the relevant period, petitioner would be entitled for the benefits of TA/DA etc. and she be granted liberty to raise her plea for this ancillary relief before the authorities.

Ordered accordingly.

It is made clear that in case request is made by petitioner to the quarter concerned within two weeks from receipt of certified copy of this order, the same shall be considered in accordance with law by passing reasoned order within eight weeks thereafter.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
