The prayer of the petitioner in the present petition is that the petitioner was entitled for regularization of his services as per the policy dated 07.03.1996 and 18.03.1996 (Annexures P-1 and P-2) and the persons, who were junior to the petitioner, were regularized under the said policy whereas, the petitioner's services were regularized only w.e.f. 01.10.2003.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that once the persons junior to the petitioner were regularized in service from a date prior to that of petitioner, the petitioner is also entitled for the said benefit once, the case of the petitioner is covered under the regularization policy dated 07.03.1996 and 18.03.1996 (Annexures P-1 and P-2).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already served a legal notice to the respondents on 16.02.2022 (Annexure P-6) raising the said grievance, which is still pending

consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied, at

this stage in case a time bound direction is given to the respondents to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Raman Kumar Sharma, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents raises no objection in deciding the legal notice dated 16.02.2022 (Annexure P-6) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the legal notice dated 16.02.2022 (Annexure P-6), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 16.02.2022 (Annexure P-6) within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
