VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.341 dated 21.12.2020 registered under Sections 323, 325, 294, 201 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station B-Division, Amritsar, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar (Annexure P-1) and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioners to take up all the points as raised in the present petition and available to them, at the relevant stage before the trial Court.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has further made a prayer that petitioner No.2 is a student and is pursuing his Company Secretary Course and thus, prays that his personal appearance before the trial Court may kindly be exempted.

In view of the abovesaid prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioner No.2 is a student and is pursuing his Company Secretary Course, thus, his personal appearance before the trial Court is exempted, subject to the following conditions:-

- i) Petitioner No.2 shall be represented through his counsel;
- ii) shall not delay/stall the trial proceedings;
- iii) shall not dispute his identity as accused;
- iv) shall have no objection if the prosecution evidence is recorded in his absence but in the presence of his counsel;
- v) shall appear before the trial Court as and when required by the trial Court;
- vi) any other condition which the trial Court may impose.
