ARUN MONGA, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner is seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus commanding the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioner as Clerk-cum-Typist, the post on which she has been working since 6.6.84, in terms of the High Court orders passed by the Division Bench on 25.7.1997 (Annexure P-15) in CWP-2194-1997.

Petition was filed in the year 1998 and has been lying admitted ever since. When called for hearing, learned counsel is unable to assist the Court for lack of instructions. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner states that despite attempts, his office could not contact the petitioner.

It seems that by sheer effluxion of time and pendency of the writ petition for more than 23 years before this Court, it has been rendered infructuous and the petitioner seems to have lost interest in pursuing the same.

Be that as it may, writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file an appropriate application in case any cause of action still survives.
