SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

1. The learned State Counsel, on instructions, meted to him, by the Investigating Officer concerned, submits that in respect of FIR No. 122 of 02.10.2019, registered at Police Station Khui Khera, District Fazilka, the Investigating Officer, after completing the investigations, has preferred a cancellation report, before the learned Magistrate concerned.
2. Therefore, the prayer made in the instant petition, qua transfer of investigations, does not survive. However, the remedy, yet, avail to the petitioner, is to make a protest against acceptance of the cancellation report, before the learned Magistrate concerned.
3. In the face of above, the present petition, at this stage, is disposed of, as becoming rendered infructuous, yet with the afore reserved liberty to the petitioner.
