This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 40 dated 17.05.2021, registered under Sections 307, 324, 323, 506, 148, 149 of the IPC at Police Station Zira, District Ferozepur.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter stands compromised between the parties and a petition bearing CRM-M-12080-2022 has already been filed before this Court seeking quashing of the FIR in question on the basis of the compromise, in which, vide order of the even date, notice has been issued for 17.05.2022 and the parties have been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaqia Magistrate for recording of their statement in support of the compromise.

Learned State counsel, assisted by learned counsel for the complainant, has not disputed the aforesaid fact.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the case, considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Illaqa Magistrate, concerned.
