The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* for issuance of directions to the respondents to grant the annual increment to the petitioner for the completion of one year service on the date of retirement and further revision of pension and pensionary benefits.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel of both the sides and on

perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with the directions to the official respondents to consider the legal notice dated 28.01.2021 (Annexure P-6) as representation moved by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the relief, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
