The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of complaint No.NACT/1401/2017 dated 22.12.2017 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 138 read with Section 141 of Negotiable Instruments Act pending before Court of JMIC, Panchkula and for quashing of summoning order dated 08.01.2018 (Annexure P-2) and all consequential proceedings passed by Court of JMIC, Panchkula.

Notice of motion was issued on 20.04.2018. Pursuant thereto reply dated 01.07.2019 by way of affidavit of Vijay Deswal, HPS Assistant Commissioner of Police, Headquarter, Panchkula had been filed.

Learned State counsel refers to para 3 thereof to submit that when the complaint in question, quashing of which along with the summoning order were sought itself has been dismissed as withdrawn vide order dated 19.04.2019, this case has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of as such.
