Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking quashing of order dated 07.05.2013, whereby he was declared proclaimed offender in case FIR No.234 dated 06.10.2011 registered under Sections 307, 120-B and 458 Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 27 Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Nakodar, District Jalandhar.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed that previously the petitioner had brought a similar petition bearing No.CRM-M-18862-2018, however, the same was not pressed and was withdrawn on 08.05.2018. Admittedly, the petitioner/accused is still residing in England and has again filed this petition for challenging the order dated 07.05.2013 (Annexure P-3), declaring him proclaimed offender in the above FIR after a gap of four years.

Considering the above background, no case is made out for exercise of inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.
