Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.10 dated 30.01.2020, under Sections 498-A, 406 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Chhajli, District Sangrur, Punjab.

Vide order dated 02.03.2020 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 02.03.2020, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute. He also submitted that thereafter, the parties have compromised all the issues.

Learned counsel for the complainant endorsed the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner and submitted that petition under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act is pending adjudication.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation. She also submitted that the challan has already been filed.

In view of the above, interim order dated 02.03.2020 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
