Fearing for life and liberty at the hands of the private respondents, the petitioner, invoking the fundamental right of life guaranteed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, has come up before this Court seeking protection through the State.

Notices served upon the official respondents through the State's counsel. Given the nature of the order that this Court proposes to pass, neither the response of official respondents nor the issuance of notices to the private respondents is required.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied in case directions may be issued to respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to decide representation dated 15.03.2022 (Annexure P-2) within time bound manner.

The prayer is not opposed.

Given above, respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to decide representation dated 15.03.2022 (Annexure P-2) by passing a speaking order within two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, the grievance of the petitioner still exists, he shall be at liberty to avail legal remedy in accordance with law including approaching this Court.

Petition is allowed to the extent mentioned above. Pending application if any, also stands disposed of.
