Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that in the present case, the respondents have passed an order in favour of the petitioner refixing her salary w.e.f. 01.04.2011 but the benefits accruing from the said order have not been released to her despite the fact that the said order was passed on 28.05.2019 (Annexure P-3). Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that non-grant of the benefits keeping in view the order dated 28.05.2019 (Annexure P-3) is causing prejudice to the petitioner and hence, the respondents may kindly be directed to grant the petitioner the consequential benefits of the said order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana,

who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that without approaching the respondents first claiming the relief in the present petition, the present writ petition has been filed and in case, the petitioner files any representation claiming the said benefits, the same will be decided in accordance with law within a period of two months of the receipt of the same by passing appropriate order and in case, the petitioner is found entitled for any benefit, the same will also be released to her.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondents by filing appropriate representation claiming the said relief.

Ordered accordingly.
