By this second such petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'regular bail' under the provisions of Section 439 Cr.P.C., upon FIR No.307, dated 29.08.2021, having been registered at Police Station Pehowa, District Kurukshetra, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 323/324/308/34 of the IPC.

Pursuant to the order dated 02.04.2022, an affidavit dated 02.05.2022 has been filed by learned State counsel, executed by the DSP, Pehowa, annexing therewith the MRI/CT scan report dated 22.04.2022, as regards such examination conducted on the complainant in the FIR, i.e Gurmeet, with another medical report dated 26.04.2022 also having been annexed with the said affidavit. The affidavit is ordered to be taken on record with a copy thereof given to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel submits that out of 9 prosecution witnesses 4 have been examined, with the next date of hearing being 02.06.2022.

Looking at the nature of injuries shown to have been received by the complainant and the effect thereof as per the aforesaid reports, I am not inclined to admit the petitioner to bail at this stage.

Consequently, this petition is dismissed at this stage.
