The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C praying for quashing of FIR No.174 dated 17.9.2017 registered under sections 323, 324, 149 IPC (section 354 IPC added later on) at Police Station, Division No.8, District Jalandhar along with all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 26.9.2017 (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in all there are six accused, however, compromise has been arrived only qua three of them, who are before this court.

Learned State counsel submits that petitioner no.1 has died and the trial is going on qua rest of the accused and out of 10 prosecution witnesses, 3 have already been examined by the Trial Court.

In view of the above position, present petition is disposed of with with liberty to the petitioners to avail the alternate remedies as may be available in accordance with law.
