[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 05.03.2019 in CWP No.4456 of 2019.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.4456 of 2019 was disposed of by directing the Deputy Commissioner, Patiala to consider and decide representation dated 04.01.2018 within six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case on consideration, the competent authority came to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner was admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief was to be allowed to the petitioner within six weeks thereafter but in case the claim was not admissible, a speaking order was to be passed in the matter.

[3] Pursuant to time taken by learned State counsel on 06.04.2022 to obtain instructions and to assist in the matter, learned AAG

has produced copy of speaking order dated 18.03.2020 passed by the competent authority rejecting the claim of the petitioner. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in view of the claim of the petitioner having been rejected by the competent authority, the petitioner may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to challenge order dated 18.03.2020 passed by the competent authority by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
