1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 02.07.2021, in CWP-9882-2021.

2. Learned DAG, Haryana, has filed reply along with speaking order Annexure R/1 deciding the appeal filed by the petitioner. Copy of reply along with Annexure R/1 dated 13.04.2022 has been furnished to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, the petitioner does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order dated 13.04.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

3. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
